

MENTAL HEALTH CONSULTANT: F/T POSITION

OHEL's Early Childhood Mental Health Program is seeking a warm, empathic, LCSW, MSW, LCAT, or LMHC with excellent communication skills to serve as a consultant to provide mental health consultation services to early childhood educational programs in Southern Queens and Nassau County. Consultants will offer professional development to pre-school teachers, classroom assessments to improve the overall learning environment, child-specific assessments to identify children who need early intervention/linkage to services, and supports for parents/caregivers.

Consultant will work collaboratively with staff at early childhood sites to facilitate increased programmatic capacity to address the mental health needs of young children. Specifically, consultants will provide guidance to the teaching staff in the development of developmentally appropriate social and emotional skills.

Appropriate candidate must have knowledge of early childhood social emotional development, experience in providing treatment to young children and/or experience working with young children in an educational setting. Bilingual a plus (Spanish).

Supervision is provided weekly which guides staff to develop competencies and new skills.
